SUMMARY OF MEETING OUTCOMES

SUMMARY OF MEETING OUTCOMES

- 1. Adoption of the Overview Report and the Action Plan for the Conservation of the Argali:** At the two-day meeting, the Range States of the Argali (see Annex to this document for the list of participants) revised and officially adopted both [the Action Plan for the Conservation of the Argali](#) (2024-2032) (hereafter 'Action Plan') the [Overview Report on the Implementation of the International Single Species Action Plan for the Conservation of the Argali \(*Ovis Ammon*\) \(2014-2024\)](#), the latter containing in addition to the overview of conservation measures of the past ten years latest information on the population numbers, trends, distribution and threats to the species .
- 2. Development of Reporting Form:** The Secretariat was tasked with developing a reporting form to facilitate monitoring and reporting on the implementation of the new Action Plan by the Range States. This form is to be developed and shared with the Range States prior to the next Range State meeting. The next meeting of Range States is to take place in 2032, subject to availability of funding.
- 3. Consideration of Technical Support for the Implementation of the Action Plan:** The Range States agreed to explore the possibility of appointing an NGO to serve as technical support for implementing the Action Plan. The Secretariat has been mandated to draft terms of reference (TOR) for this supporting role, which will be circulated to the Range States for approval via correspondence. Upon receiving approval for the TOR, the Secretariat will initiate a call for expressions of interest from qualified NGOs to fulfil this role in a consultative process with the Range States.
